## **Canvas Print & Play Instructions**

**Player Count:** This Print and Play contains enough components for 1-2 player games. (The final game will be playable up to 5 players.)

**Cards:** Cut out the 9 Scoring cards (*The final game will have 12 tarot-sized Scoring cards*) and the 30 Art cards (*The final game will have 60 tarot-sized Art cards*) along the dotted lines. Cut out the empty slots at the bottom of the Art cards so that each has exactly 2 tabs like this example:





**Sleeves:** If you have clear sleeves, we recommend sleeving the Art cards to avoid the tabs getting tangled or ripped. (*The final game's Art cards will be made of clear plastic, so they won't have tabs.*) The rules state that you should sleeve 3 Art cards together when completing a painting. I don't recommend doing this for the Print & Play. Instead, just lay the cards on top of each other.

**Inspiration Tokens:** Use coins or tokens from another board game. You'll need 4 tokens per player.

**Play Mat:** You do not need the play mat for the Print & Play.

**Ribbons:** Use 32 cubes or tokens (4 colors, 8 of each color) from another board game or cut out the ribbons below:






