Droplets Print & Play (Alternative Boards)

Game Mechanics

Droplets is a strategic placement, area control, chain reaction game, in which you play droplets of water onto the board. As droplets accumulate in a space, they can trigger a *splash*, causing all the droplets within to move outwards. These can, in turn, cause other splashes to be triggered – though not always under your control, and not always for your benefit.

Your goal is to *splash* your droplets onto the fountains around the board, while sending your opponents' down the drain.

The game can be played from 2 to 5 players.

What you need

- Approximately 40 tokens per player, each in different colors/shapes. 10x10mm cubes work just fine, but you can use beads, jewels, or any other small token available.
- An Active Player marker.

Instructions

- In this file you will find **4 different board styles**. For **each board**, a 3+ players is provided, and in the next page you'll find a 2-player version of the same, mirrored. The 2-player version doesn't have the reference for 4-droplet splashes, making it a cleaner interface if you only play with 2 players.
 - o In pages 2 and 3, you'll find the original board. Fountains closest to the center (near the middle of the page) score 1 point, while fountains at both extremes of the board score 2 points.
 - o In pages 4 and 5, there's a smaller triangular version. All fountains are equal, and score 1 point.
 - o In pages 6 and 7, the smallest version of a board I could muster, while keeping it challenging. All fountains are equal and score 1 point. On this board, the game *is shorter*.
 - o In pages 8 and 9, a square board. Fountains in the center score 1 point, while fountains in the corners score 2 points.
- You only need one board to play, and therefore you only need to print one page, but you can print all, if you want to try all of them.
